Sickness/Illness Policy



Please note that if a child has symptoms of vomiting, diarrhoea, high temperature (or an unidentified rash), s/he then should be taken to the doctor ASAP. S/he should be away from nursery for at least 48 hours (e.g. after the last episode of the symptom(s) or has instructed by the doctor)

**Please inform the nursery about the outcome, with an evidence report from the doctors. This is the current regulation regarding infection control and cross contamination (from the Government's Public Health Department) and would like to inform the parents/carers that it's our obligation to comply with it.
