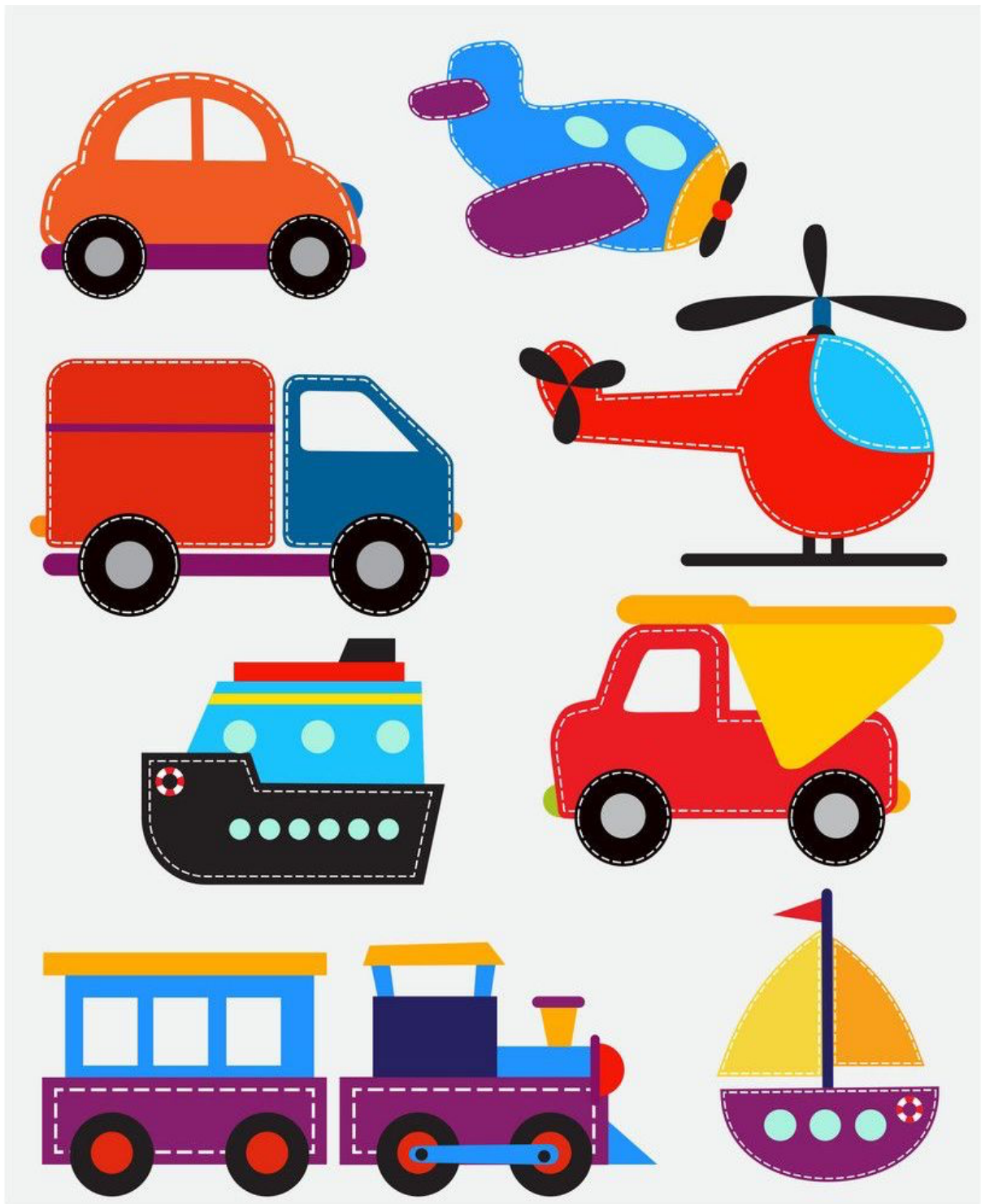
Welcome to our newsletter for the month of August.

### **Topic Of The Month**

Our topic of the month is Transportation and our primary aim is to educate children on road safety and different modes of transport. Children will be introduced to vehicles such as train, planes, cars, trucks, rockets and so forth. As per normal we will use the children's interests and next steps to recreate meaningful experiences to promote understanding of the world and fun learning.



### **Books Of The Month**

Our new book of the month for the Tweenies and Preschool room is Whatever Next. The book aims to increase our children's imagination by promoting role play and allowing children to explore resources independently.

The new book of the month for the Baby room is Thomas The Tank Engine. This book will introduce children to the train sounds and Thomas The Tank Engine adventures.

### **Baby room activities**

The baby room colour of the month is yellow.

Our team will continue with the transport theme, create sensory activities and create wonderful boards to support the new topic.

The principal aim is to improve communication skills and create awareness of different modes of transportation through the use of different textures, paint colours, images and sounds.

The children will also be encouraged to engage in a pop bus activity and many art and craft activities.

### **Tweenies' room activities**

Our Tweenies team will focus on creating road safety awareness and talking about traffic light colours.

Our Tweenies will learn the rocket count down from five to zero.

Furthermore, we will encourage our children to talk about how they travel to the nursery and what mode of transport they use.

Tweenies may also take advantage of red indoor card box bus to create a role play.

### **Preschool activities**

In addition to continuing the transport theme, our Preschool team will learn the rocket count down from ten to zero.

The Preschool team will also pay particular attention to the name of each underground train line and the colour of each train line.

Preschoolers will also focus on how they will travel to their new schools in September.

Preschool will practice transportation role plays both in the nursery and the big garden using toy cars, trains and other available vehicles.
