Baby room activities

Our babies this month will explore the Summer topic through sensory activities: play with sand and shape the sand, splashing in the water and play with the fish etc. They will discover the colour of "blue" and how they can learn it with different materials: painting, paper, glitter and edible colour etc.

To support babies' communication skills and help them to learn new sounds and words, we will use new flashcards linking to the summer, we will read their favourite stories and supporting them with puppets, singing their favourite songs and introduce new ones.

The story of the month will be "Rainbowfish" and the song of the month will be "Under the sea".

Tweenies-Preschool activities

In the main room, our children will explore the new topic in different ways: at the creative area, they will use different material like sand, fish shapes, glue, glitter and everything they like to create their "summer collage".

They will practise their writing skill by copying some summer words. Also, preschool children will focus on the letter of the week, and they will enjoy singing and learning Jolly Phonics every morning.

This month our role play area will be changed into "under the sea" the children will pretend to be on holiday, swim in the sea, play with a different kind of fish and make sandcastles.

The story of the month will be "Rainbowfish". Children will have a chance to talk about the story, what their favourite characters are and they will discuss about friendship and sharing. Our aim is to delivery the message that everyone is different, but everyone is a friend. We also would like to help them to understand "sharing is caring".

In the math area, the question will be: How many fish will you see?
